

Haryana Judiciary Exam Pattern

The exam consists of 3 stages namely - Prelims, Mains and Interview.

Haryana Judiciary Exam Pattern: Prelims

1. The objective-type questions with multiple-choice answers for the Preliminary exam syllabus shall be **from the syllabus for the Main Examination.**
 2. The question paper for Preliminary Examination shall be of two hours duration.
 3. It shall consist of a maximum of 125 questions and
 4. Each question shall carry 4 marks and for every wrong answer 0.80 i.e. 20% or say 1/5th mark shall be deducted.
- **Topics to be covered:** Questions will be asked from Current Affairs, Indian Legal History, Constitutional Development, and Acts mentioned under Civil Law 1, Civil Law II, and Criminal Law.

Haryana Judiciary Exam Pattern: Mains

This is a subjective type of paper. The marks of this stage will determine the overall merit. The details are as follows.

1. Main Examination shall consist of six papers- five written and a viva voce.
2. Main Examination will be subjective/narrative type. Main Examination will be conducted in English Medium except for language papers.
3. Each written paper shall be of three hours duration.
4. The standard of the language paper shall be that of the Matriculation Examination of the Board of School Education, Haryana.

Interview - Viva-Voce - Paper-VI { 200 Marks }

To judge the personal qualities of the candidates. The viva-voce shall relate to the matters of general interest and is intended to test the candidates' alertness, intelligence and general outlook, It shall be conducted in English.
